From My Heart to Yours

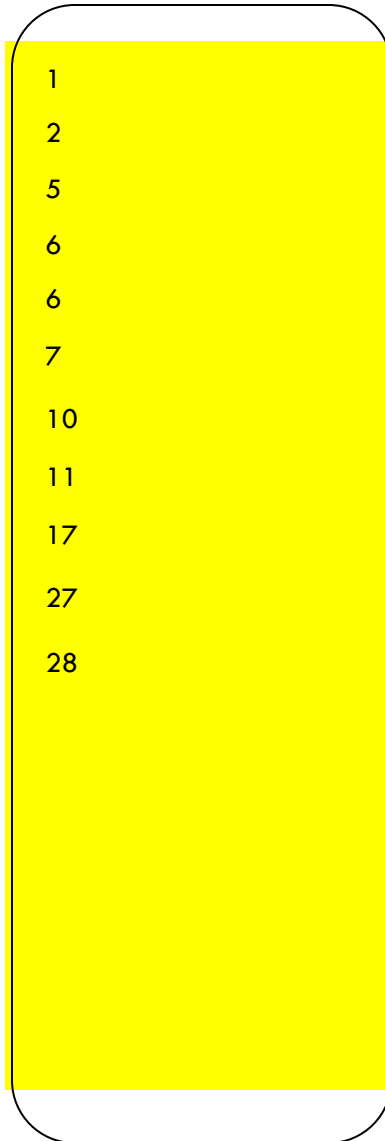
One day, Jesus had an interesting conversation with two of his disciples. James and John came to Jesus and asked about a future "promotion." (Mark 10:35) They wanted to be Jesus' "right hand" and "left hand" men in the coming kingdom. The gist of how Jesus answered them was, "Look, you REALLY don't know what you are talking about -- and besides, it is not for me to give. Only the Father knows who will sit on the right and the left" (paraphrase, Mark 10:37-40). After the other disciples, were beginning to feel animosity toward James and John about their ambition, Jesus used this as a teaching opportunity. (Mark 10:41-45).

Basically, Jesus says to them and to us: First, you need to think differently about how you handle authority. Second, being great in the Kingdom of God is about serving -- not about bossing others around. And third, remember that Jesus, himself, demonstrated the ultimate sacrifice of service when He went to the cross on our behalf. Brothers and sisters -- this is who we are: servants of God and of one another. Anything more invites jealousy, ill-will and blind ambition. "You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love." (Gal 5:13)

Praise the Lord! - for His faithfulness through His people. Our goal for Lottie Moon (International Missions) was \$1500. As of this writing, we have received a little over \$2200! -- All of these funds will go around the world to preach the Gospel to those who have never heard the Good News of Jesus.
