**How Did Sunday School Start?**

**Robert Raikes**, British journalist, philanthropist, and pioneer of the Sunday-school movement. Noting the unsupervised behaviour of Gloucester children on Sundays, in 1780 Raikes engaged a number of women to teach reading and the church catechism on Sundays. The experiment was so successful that he could record in the *Gloucester Journal* (Nov. 3, 1783) that the district had become "quite a heaven upon Sundays." The Sunday-school movement spread rapidly to all parts of the country.
